

## **Dear Q&A**

I am an internal auditor who wrote an evidence-based report that the chief executive officer told me to change — I refused and now my job is at risk — what can I do?

## **Answer**

Unfortunately, there is no easy answer to your dilemma.

Every year, the IIA-Australia hears from members whose jobs come under pressure because of reports they have written, or who are terminated from their jobs because their work put management in a difficult position that management created themselves. You would likely be surprised how frequently this happens.

The IIA-Australia has prepared a Factsheet 'Internal Auditor Under Pressure' which seeks to provide practical guidance to internal auditors facing this situation.
