
DATA SHARING

BUILDING A DATA GOVERNANCE FRAMEWORK

- Start small, as with all processes, strive for quick wins and build on them
- Set clear and measurable goals
- Define ownership
- Identify roles and responsible, it is a team from all parts of the business
- Education, education, education, translate the process into meaningful context for others
- Make sure the framework integrates into the way of doing business
- Map the IT landscape
- Develop standardised data definition
- Identify the critical data elements and define control measurements
- Communicate frequently!
