








Collaboration Channels







Legal Services



- Provide advice across the organisation on issues including risks, processes and governance (probity)
- Update management on legislative changes
- Identification of better practices





Internal Audit



- Assurance on council processes and operations
 through internal audits
- Administrative support to Risk & Audit Committee
- Provide probity advice at times
- Liaison between Risk & Audit committee, management and external auditors





Corporate Planning



- Provide organisational support to meet legislative requirements Planning and Reporting
- Update management on legislative changes
- Identification of better practices related to business
 planning and measurement





Legal Services, Corporate Planning and Internal Audit



- Independent roles
- Provide services across entire organisation
- Focus on business improvement
- Risk management





Useable Information



- Reliable, accurate and context specific data is required to generate usable information
- Usable information is in turn at the heart of Business Assurance processes
- Audit, Legal and Corporate Planning functions are underpinned by usable information





Audit and Corporate Planning Linkage




- Legislation changes to Local Government Act



| Collaboration | Similar roles Focussed on business assurance activities |
| Adaptability | Informal situation allows adaptability Working across the organisation Refocus roles to align with business improvement |

Strengthening Business Relationships – Day to Day



- Regular informal discussions on issues as they arise
- Exchange of information and ideas
- Broader discussion around significant issues





Benefits of Strong Internal Relationships



- Professional support
- Avoidance of duplication where possible
- Value to the organisation
- Recent issues are discussed
- Superior advice as issues are known
- Improved use of time and resources



Considerations for Future



- Develop database of audits and legal advices.
- Inclusion of Risk, Audit and Corporate Planning as one software solution
- Strengthening ties with Risk and Governance
- Improve business alignment across the organisation
- Increased use of cross-functional teams within the organisation
